- I think some more in class writing would be helpful, maybe some creative or fiction writing. It would be a little more exciting than watching a powerpoint.
- I think it would be a really good idea to put more time into improving our way of writing by introducing new techniques and learning some interesting vocabulary.
- I personally liked the idea of some of the projects, but the projects themselves were a little too narrow to be of use. I would have liked to see the projects be a little more open ended in terms of the final product but overall, the projects helped me to better my analytical practices.
- I felt the class was very rigid and structured for an English course. I would have appreciated having more leeway when it comes to writing than being forced to write a specific style for a specific purpose.
- Have more work time.
- Have conferences be longer and more in depth about your paper.
