

Learning Outcomes

Our course will help you work toward several of the P2W and XA program learning outcomes.

P2W students will work toward the following:

- Students will demonstrate attention to rhetorical contexts.
- Students will identify their responsibility as communicators and community members.
- Students will collaborate with attention to project management and citizenship.
- Students will create with attention to their own positionality as well as the cultures and communities they create for and within.
- Students will learn how to learn in professional and public writing contexts.

XA students will work toward the following:

- Students will evaluate how their own experiences and positionality influence their design and research processes.
- Students will reflect on experiences in order to monitor continued learning and growth.
- Students will integrate knowledge of culture and partner communities into their design and research practices.
- Students will explain the practices and knowledge associated with working in fields associated with XA (including user-experience, user research, artificial intelligence, computer science, content strategy, accessibility, etc.).
- Students will evaluate the steps and processes involved in executing multi-step and iterative projects.

More specifically, by the end of this course, you will

- describe a workplace culture, paying special attention to community values, communication, and structure.
- discuss your positionality within that workplace culture.
- connect what you're doing and learning at your internship with what you've done and learned in P2W/XA.
- narrate an internship experience to demonstrate professional knowledge, skills, and methods.
- reflect on how and what you learn in your internship.
